



Objective of the event:

Organ donation is the process when a person allows an <u>organ</u> of their own to be removed and <u>transplanted</u> to another person, <u>legally</u>, either by <u>consent</u> while the donor is alive or dead with the assent of the next of kin. Donation may be for research or, more commonly, healthy <u>transplantable organs and tissues</u> may be donated to be transplanted into another person. To increase the number of organ donors, especially among underrepresented populations, current approaches include the use of optimized social network interventions, exposing tailored educational content about organ donation to target social media users. Every year August 13 is observed as **World Organ Donation Day** to raising awareness about the importance of organ donation. 
