

PHYSIOTHERAPY WEEK (DAY 2) **COMMUNITY OUTREACH/ SURVEY**

SOP of Program:

Objective:

To assess the prevalence, risk factors, and healthcare needs related to arthritis in Dhanod

Survey questionnaires

Data collection devices (smartphones, tablets, paper forms)

Maps of the village

Personal protective equipment (if applicable)

Consent forms

Recording and storage equipment (laptops, hard drives)

Procedure:

1. Project Planning:

Define the objectives of the survey.

Identify the study population (e.g., all adults in the village).

Determine the sample size required for statistical significance.

Create a survey questionnaire that includes questions about arthritis symptoms, medical history, lifestyle, and demographics.

Develop a sampling strategy (random, stratified, etc.).




Brief outline addressed in the event:

Brief outline addressed in the event:

The physiotherapy department of healthcare sector of Swarrnim start-up and innovation university had organised the Community awareness survey at the village named Moti Adaraj on 20th January, 2023. The Awareness camp was intended to spread the information about physiotherapy field.

All students prepared the paper charts on regards of awareness of physiotherapy. The day of survey was started at morning 9:30 A.M at the campus of Venus institute of physiotherapy, where displaying of all charts were done. The work of survey was divided among students. They all were guided by Dr. Nehansi Chauhan, Dr. Kosha Gor and Dr. Honey Panchal. All villagers got an ergonomically correct advice and home-based exercise program.

At the end of the survey, we were being concluded that villagers were facing more occupation-based problems and pain in weight bearing joints as compare to others. Students enjoyed the survey and day ended on great note.

All the Students of Venus Institute of Physiotherapy were present and they attended that seminar nicely. He appeals to all the students to do such practice of interpretation of ECG regularly.


