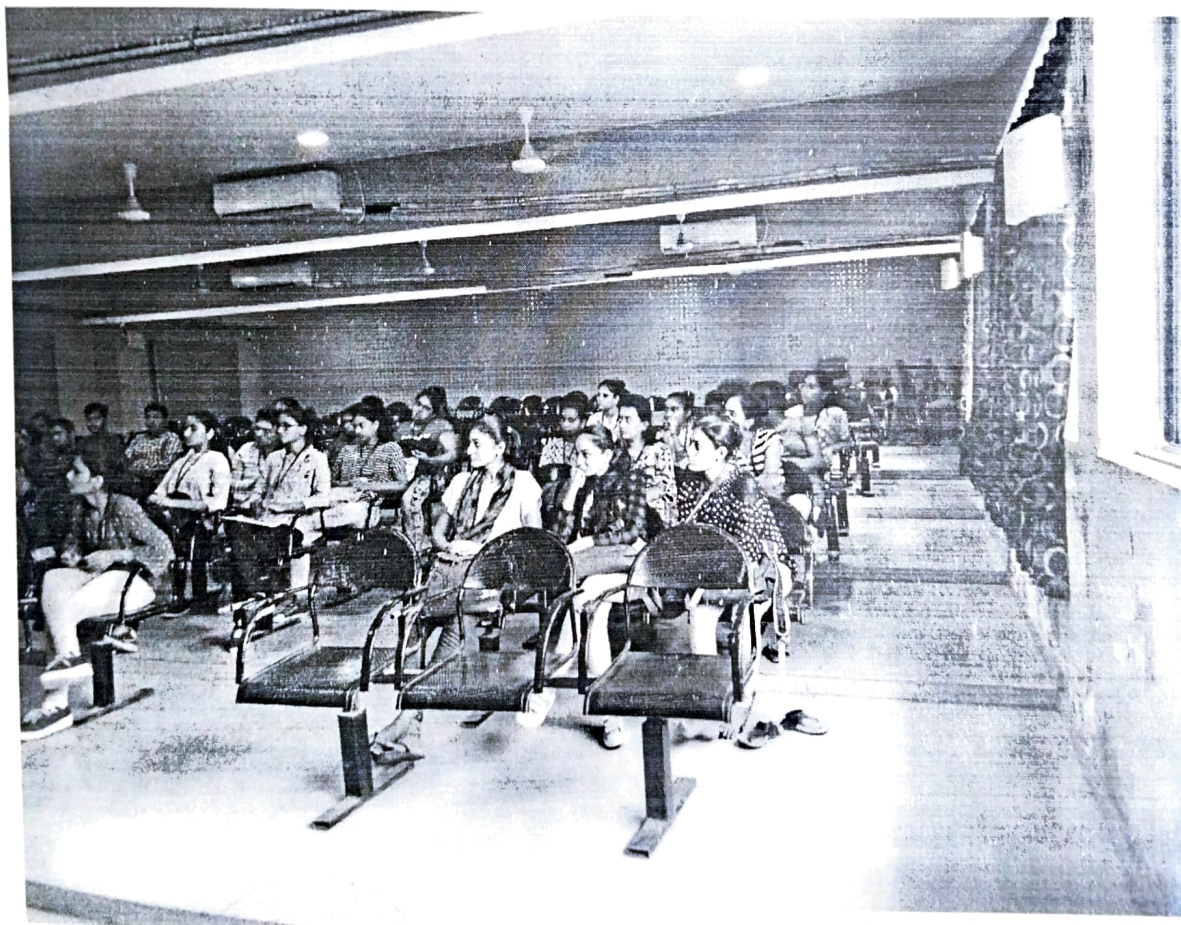
## Summary

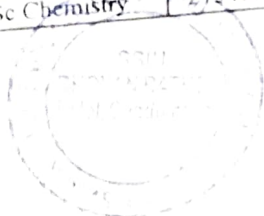

**Transportation and Logistics:** The Institute has arranged transportation and other logistical support for the students who needed it during the visit.

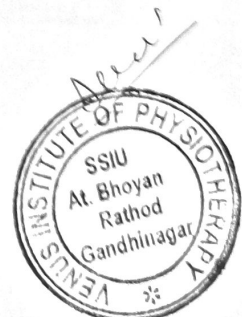
