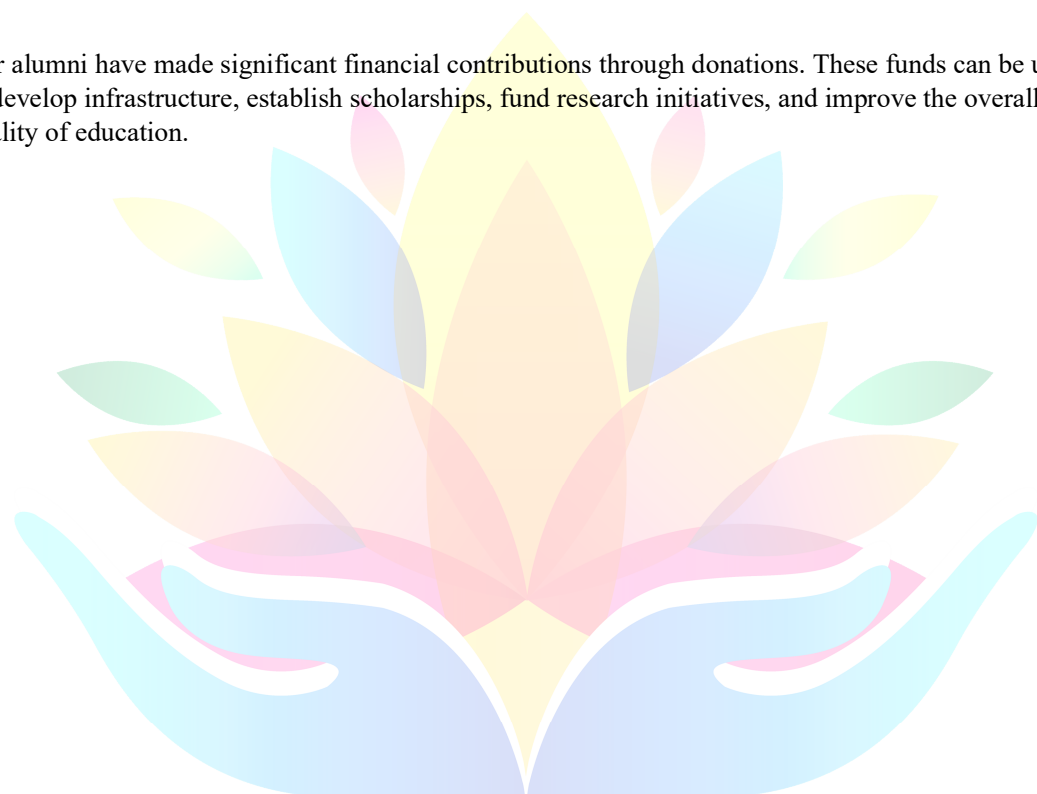

## Overview

Since 2019, Swarnnim Startup & Innovation University has hosted biannual alumni meets each April and September. The inaugural 2019 meet featured casual cultural performances, including traditional Garba and fusion music, accompanied by a communal luncheon with faculty. In 2020, despite pandemic constraints, alumni engaged virtually in reflective sessions within the seminar hall and interactive circle-based virtual games fostering camaraderie.

The 2021 gatherings emphasized hybrid formats: small-scale on-campus assemblies with reminiscence sessions supported by faculty, supplemented by socially distanced circle-oriented ice-breaker games that encouraged creative participation. In 2022, the university expanded activities with innovative ground games, integrating seated circle challenges that required teamwork and strategic thinking, alongside traditional reminiscence forums in the seminar hall.

The 2023–24 chapter, christened “Smriti Sangam,” elevated the experience through structured nostalgia-driven panels featuring diverse batches, interactive circle games blending alumni from all years, and thematic seminars addressing professional development. Most recently, the 2024–25 “Ritambhara Alumni Meets” have achieved unparalleled engagement: four dynamic events punctuated by immersive circle-based innovation games, curated reminiscence discussions in the main auditorium, and collaborative showcases of alumni achievements.

Over six years, these biannual reunions have evolved from casual cultural festivities to sophisticated, multifaceted celebrations that deepen institutional affinity and cross-cohort collaboration thus.

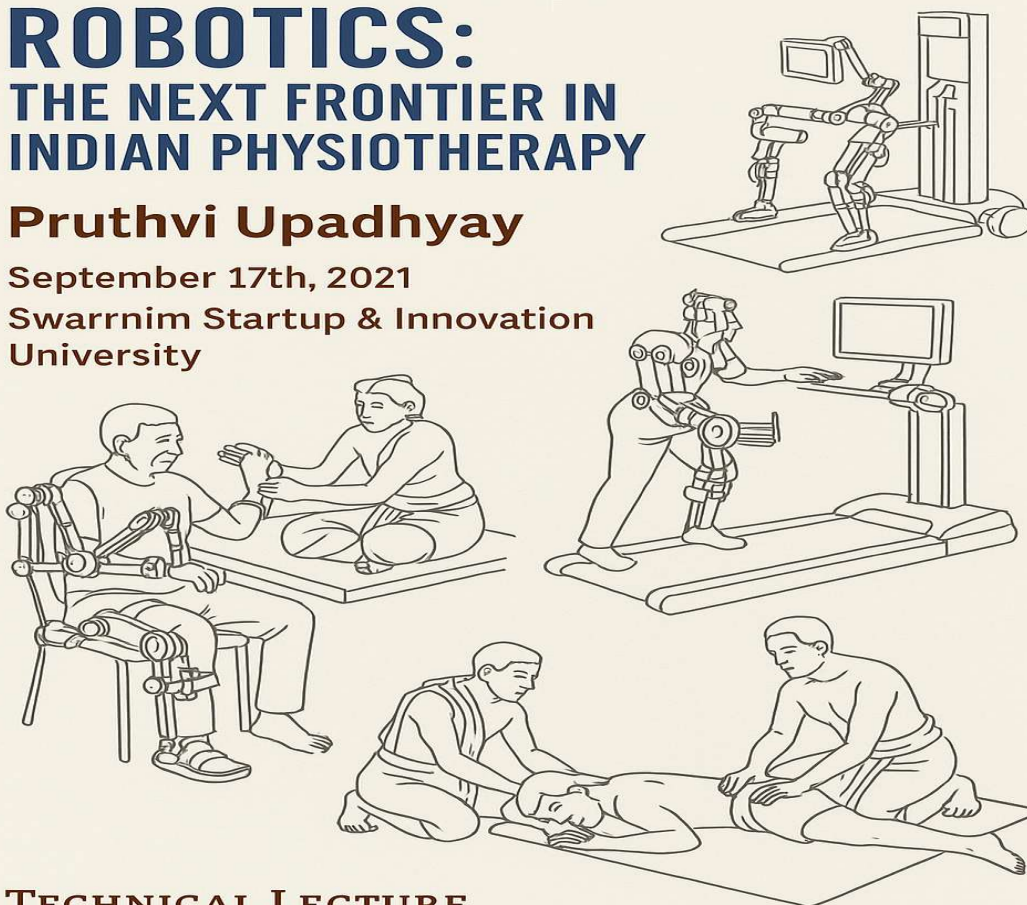



### 3. Startups, Scaleups & Software Ecosystems: Lessons from Gujarat's Founders

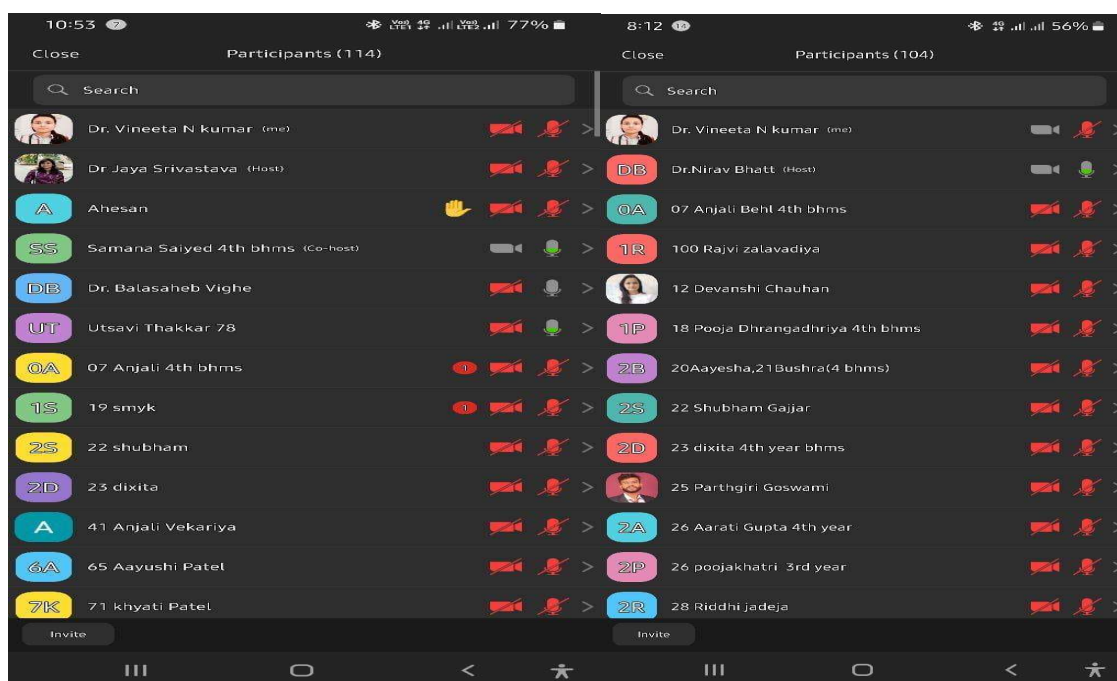
