Conclusion: Overall Impact

The evidence from the data is unequivocal. Remedial classes have been highly effective for these students.

- Universal Improvement: Every single student analysed showed a positive improvement in their average score.
- **Significant Growth:** The average improvement of +1.68 points is substantial, often meaning the difference between a fail and a pass, or a pass and a high grade.
- From Weak to Strong: Many students (e.g., Chaudhari Roshan, Chaudhari Het) were consistently scoring 2s ("Before") and improved to consistently scoring 4s and 5s ("After"), indicating a deep understanding of the material gained in the remedial sessions.
