
2. Process & Departmental Initiatives:

Purpose of this report:

Leading recruiters like TCS, Capgemini, BYJU'S, HDFC, IBM, and several startups have regularly hired our students. With the highest domestic package reaching ₹10 LPA, the university maintains an average placement rate of 75% above. Extensive pre-placement training, industry-specific modules, and strong corporate tie-ups have contributed to both placement success and entrepreneurial outcomes among graduates.
