1.1.1 Course Outcomes (COs) (05)

Course outcomes (COs) are the statements indicating what a student can do after the successful completion of a course. Every Course leads to some Course Outcomes. The CO statements are defined by considering the course content covered in each module of a course. For every course there may be 4 to 6 COs. The keywords used to define COs are based on Bloom's Taxonomy. The Course Outcomes are defined in accordance with the University curriculum.

CO-PO matrices Methodology

- Students need to develop certain qualities to effectively contribute to industry, academia, and society. These qualities are defined as Program Outcomes (POs), and the curriculum is structured to foster them.
- Based on how well the course content supports achieving each PO (e.g., PO1, PO2, PO3, etc.), courses are rated as substantial (3), moderate (2), or slight (1) in their contribution.
- Faculty members align Course Outcomes (COs) with POs, considering the broader goals and relevance of the course. This mapping is finalized through discussions in departmental committee meetings and institution-wide faculty meetings, resulting in the CO-PO Matrix.
- The correlation between COs and POs are established through the process given below:
 - **Step 1:** COs defined by the faculty or given by council are mapped with the Program outcomes.
 - **Step 2:** For each course, the average value of POs is obtained.
 - **Step 3:** Step 2 is carried out for all the courses in the program.

Internal assessment (IA)	50	50%	➤ The overall evaluation of students' performance consists of two main components: Internal Assessment: 50% of the total marks. University Examination: 50% of the total marks. This split ensures both continuous assessment and final examination performance are fairly considered. ➤ Internal Assessment (50%) is designed to evaluate students continuously throughout the semester, promoting regular study habits and engagement. It is further divided into three components: ➤ Internal Examination (20 marks): Conducted periodically during the semester. Tests students' understanding of the syllabus covered up to that point. May include written tests, quizzes, or mid-semester exams.
University assessment (End semester Examination)	50	50%	Encourages regular participation in classes. Marks are awarded based on the percentage of classes attended. Promotes discipline and consistent learning. Assignment (20 marks): Based on submission of assignments given by the faculty. May involve problem-solving tasks, essays, projects, or practical exercises. Aims to develop research, analytical, and writing skills. This internal assessment structure ensures that students are evaluated not only on their final exam performance but also on their regular participants, attendance, and engagement with the course material.





Criteria for Pass: As per the general passing criteria, students must secure a minimum of 50% marks separately in both Internal Assessment and University Examination for each course. This rule applies individually to all theory and practical courses, which are treated as separate subjects. Internal assessment includes components like tests, assignments, and attendance, while the university exam is conducted at the end of the semester. Passing one component does not compensate for failing the other. Students must meet the minimum in both to be considered as having passed the subject. This ensures consistent performance throughout the course in both internal and external evaluations.

1.2.2 Record the attainment of Course Outcomes of all courses with respect to set attainment levels

Following Procedure is followed for the assessment of attainment of COs through Internal Assessment marks and end semester marks:

Setting of attainment levels:

Step 1: Course Outcome attainment levels: The CO attainment levels are set for each course in the final examination as target. Accordingly, the target levels for CO attainment are set.

Step 2: Criteria for setting and improvement of the target levels: For every course the target level for an assessment year is set on the basis of the target achieved in the previous year. For any course, achieving the maximum attainment level of 3 during the assessment year, the attainment level for the subsequent year shall be redefined by increasing the target marks. Table presents the target levels for CO attainment.

Step 3: Weightage and CO attainment achieved: As per the University curriculum, the total marks for the theory courses is 100, Accordingly the weightage adopted for the program are:

- 50% weightage for University examination and
- 50% weightage for internal assessment.

Attainment of Cos:

The attainment of COs is taken as the average of attainment of all the CO's for the course and expressed as CO-IA (20% weightage of CO attainment through IA tests). However, the institution is not accessible to the distribution of marks to corresponding COs from University results, with that as constraint CO-FE (CO attainment through semester examination) is computed as 80% of final examination. Together is expressed as the attainment of CO for the particular course.
