

• Observations based on the Faculty Feedback Questionnaire responses:

- 1. Faculty expressed concern about the limited clinical exposure due to fewer hospital hours.
- 2. Faculty highlighted the lack of postgraduate programs as a barrier to career advancement.
- 3. Faculty suggested improvements to the curriculum's relevance to current industry trends and advancements.
- 4. Faculty expressed satisfaction with the department's commitment to ethical practices and patient care.

• Suggestions received from Faculty Members:

- 1. Increase the allocation of clinical hours to provide more hands-on experience.
- 2. Explore the possibility of establishing postgraduate programs to enhance faculty development and research capabilities.
- 3. Update the curriculum to incorporate the latest research and evidence-based practices.
- 4. Enhance interdisciplinary collaboration with other healthcare professionals.

• Suggested Action:

- 1. Advocate for increased allocation of clinical hours to provide students with adequate hands-on experience from next Academic Session.
- 2. Develop a strategic plan to establish postgraduate programs in the department from next Academic Session.
