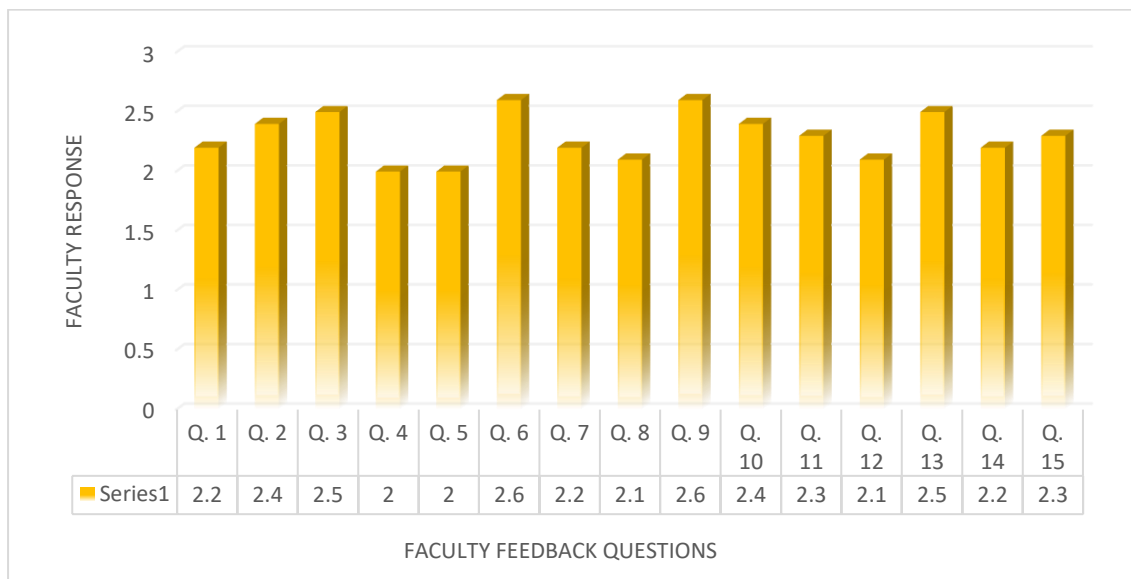

- **Observations based on the Faculty Feedback Questionnaire responses:**

1. Faculty expressed concern about the limited clinical exposure due to fewer hospital hours.
2. Faculty highlighted the lack of postgraduate programs as a barrier to career advancement.
3. Faculty suggested improvements to the curriculum's relevance to current industry trends and advancements.
4. Faculty expressed satisfaction with the department's commitment to ethical practices and patient care.

- **Suggestions received from Faculty Members:**

1. Increase the allocation of clinical hours to provide more hands-on experience.
