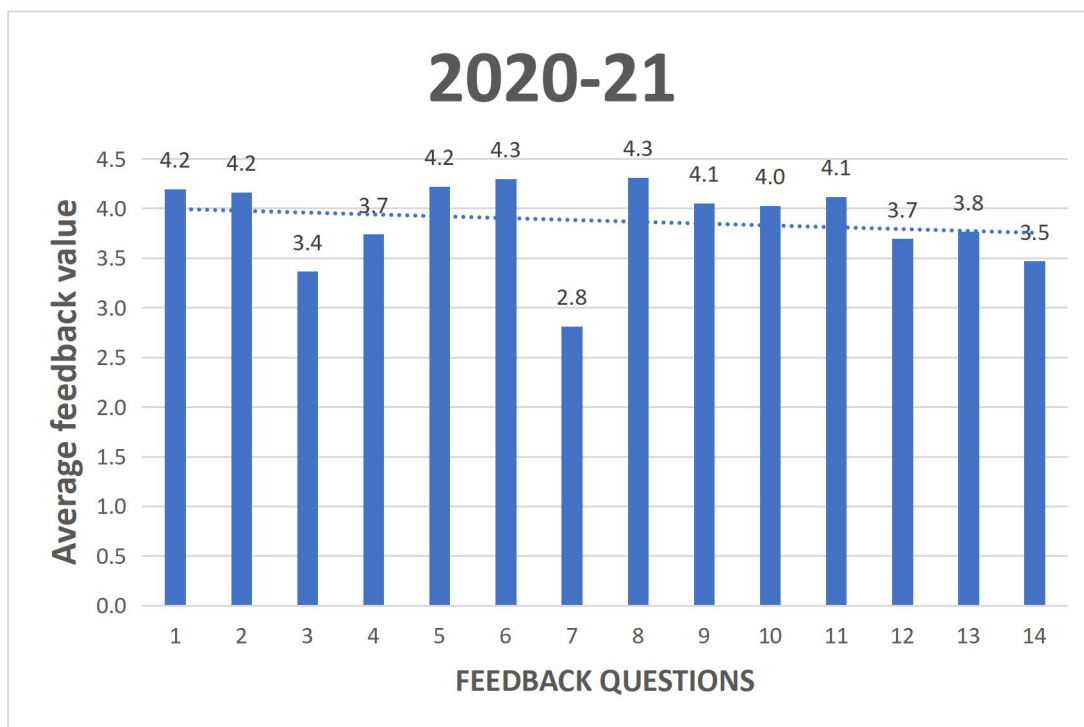

### Suggestions received from students

1. A more practical approach must be adopted for teaching.

3. Training must be imparted for Soft skills.
4. Regular case presentations must be carried out by faculties and students.
5. More seminars and workshops must be organised by the institute for exposure.
6. Entrepreneurship skills must be taught on regular basis.
7. Continuous evaluation must be there.
8. Preparation and standardization of Ayurvedic medicines must be taught.
