

1. Observations Based on Student Feedback

- Introduction of New Syllabus for Neurological Sciences (MPT): Students pursuing their Master of Physiotherapy (MPT) appreciated the new syllabus for Neurological Sciences, finding it relevant and timely. However, they suggested more practical demonstrations and case-based learning modules to enhance clinical understanding.
- **Sports Lectures**: Students from various departments expressed enthusiasm for incorporating **sports lectures** into the curriculum, acknowledging the importance of physical well-being and its relevance in many fields, especially in physiotherapy and health sciences. Some recommended increasing the frequency and depth of these lectures.
- Exposure to Conferences & Presentations: Students highly valued opportunities for conference participation, and poster and paper presentations, but requested more chances to participate. Many felt that these experiences would help in developing their professional skills and enhancing their resumes.

2. Suggestions from Students

- MPT Neurological Sciences: More hands-on workshops and clinical exposure related to neurological conditions were suggested, alongside case study reviews and simulated patient scenarios for better practical understanding.
- Sports Lectures: Students recommended integrating sports science modules, inviting guest lectures from sports industry professionals, and adding more practical sessions related to injury prevention, rehabilitation, and sports fitness.
- Conferences & Presentations: Students proposed that the institution should facilitate more participation in national and international conferences. They also asked for internal events that allow practice in paper and poster presentations, as well as workshops on scientific writing and presentation skills.

3. Suggested Actions

• Neurological Sciences (MPT):

- Enhance the syllabus with clinical workshops, more practical assessments, and patient-based learning.
- o Introduce **collaborative seminars** with neurological professionals and experts for real-world case discussions.

• Sports Lectures:

- Increase the number of sports-related modules and include them in the regular curriculum for all health science students.
- Arrange guest lectures by sports physiotherapists and trainers, and hold practical sports sessions to ensure students apply what they learn.

Conference Exposure:

- Organize more internal events for student paper and poster presentations, and offer guidance on preparing for conferences.
- o Provide **financial and logistical support** for students attending **national and international conferences**, and encourage faculty to promote such opportunities.
