

Observations Based on the Faculty Feedback Questionnaire Responses:

- 1. The effectiveness of the curriculum in developing analytical and problem solving skills is very bad.
- 2. The relevance of the curriculum in terms of recent trends and practices in respective discipline is very bad.
- 3. The theory and pratical components in the curriculum to make the students employable are very bad.
- 4. Curriculum is very bad in terms of facilitating the overall holistic development of the student.

5. The courses taught are very bad and must inculcate lifelong learning and human ethics/ values.

Suggestion received from Student Members:

- 1. Integrate more ethics-based content in various subjects.
- 2. Improve problem-solving exercises in the curriculum.
- 3. More time should be given in computer labs.
- 4. Evaluation methods should test both theory and practical knowledge.
- 5. Curriculum should be developing analytical and problem-solving skills.
- 6. Recent trends and practices in my discipline.
- 7. More presentation, projects, case studies etc. to be taught.
- 8. I want courses that teach me to keep learning beyond college and promote ethical.

Suggested Actions:

- 1. Taking into account the dissatisfaction regarding the syllabus not covering the most recent trends under the relevant topic a provision will be made to introduce the most recent trends in the curriculum to be proposed in BOS 2023-24 will be signed.
- 2. A provision will be made to introduce several skill enriching certificate courses by industry experts.
- 3. Up to date relevant subjects and topics will be introduced.
- 4. A provision will be made to increase the computer lab hours to make the students more efficient in its usage.
- 5. Value added courses as per NEP2020 will be introduced in BOS 2023-24.
