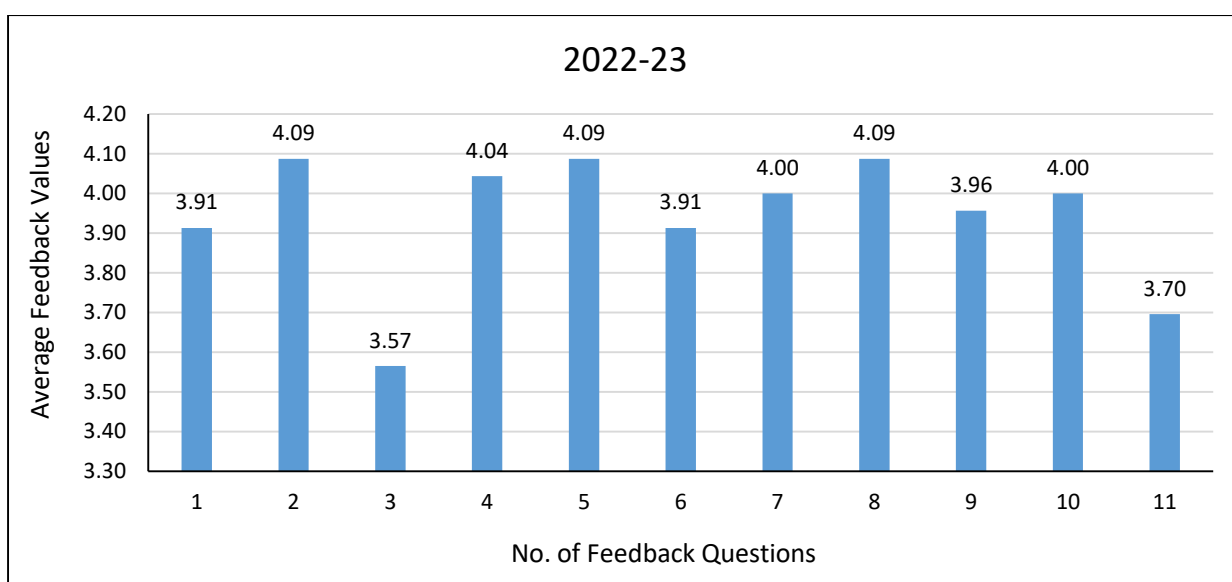

1. It has been observed that the effectiveness of the curriculum in developing analytical and problem solving skills is very bad.
2. The curriculum in terms of facilitating the overall holistic development of the students is very bad.
3. According to the corporate the efficiency of the course providing soft skills knowledge is bad
4. It has been observed that the applicability of the tools/ case studies presented in the curriculum is good.
5. The performance of value added courses and domain specific electives is good.

Suggestions received from Corporate Members:

1. More number of hands-on learning or projects.
2. Balance between foundational concepts and the latest technological advancements to be maintained.
3. Curriculum should encourage the development of intellectual, emotional, and social skills.
4. I prefer a balance between learning concepts and applying them in practical situations.
5. Combination of theoretical knowledge and practical experience to prepare the students for the job market.
6. If the curriculum stays focused on old topics, it might not prepare the students for modern jobs.
7. Research projects and internships to be more as it will expose the students to actual tools and case studies used in the field.

Suggested action:

1. The major minor specialization offered in the program along with soft skill training will be discussed in BOS meeting to be scheduled in 2023-24.
2. More components in the course will be added to make student employable.
3. More relevant case studies and researches to be discussed in the class.
4. Innovation and relevant entrepreneurship skills to be added in the curriculum.
