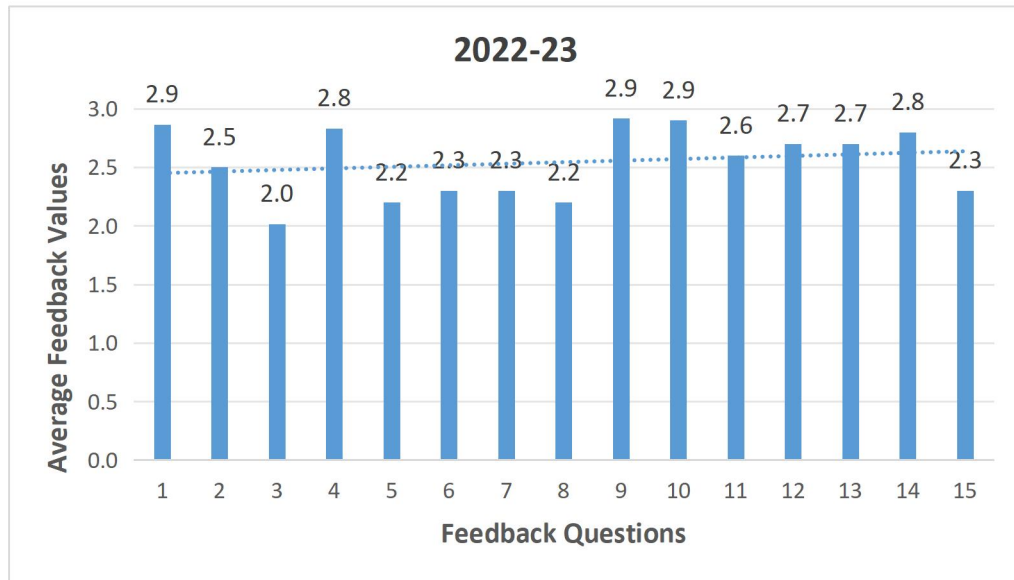

### **Observation Based on the faculty Feedback Questionnaire responses**
