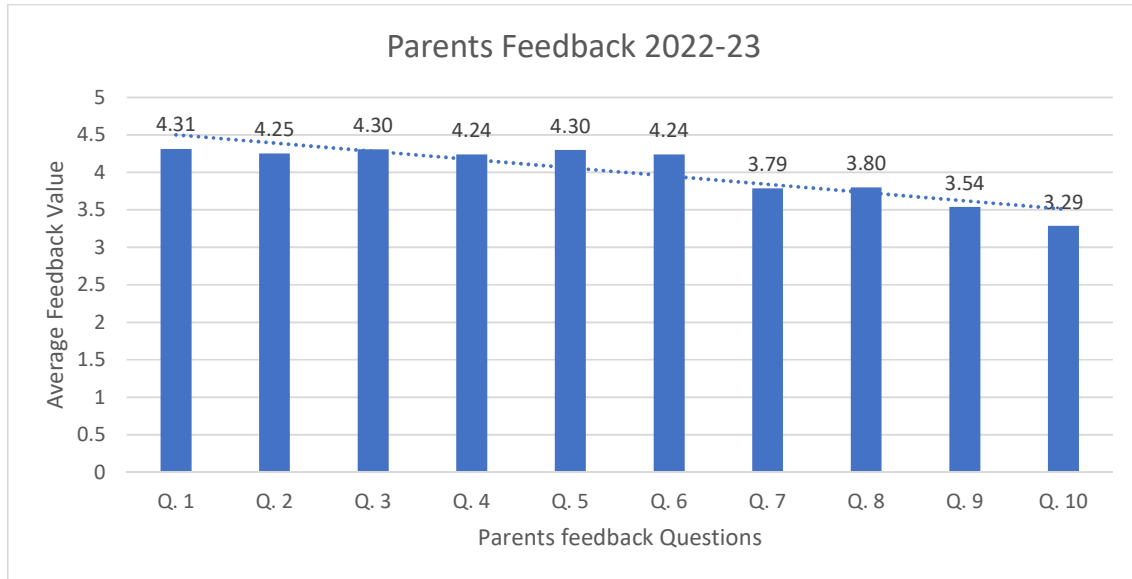

Suggestion received from Parents:
