

- 1. Value-added courses and Domain specific electives are excellently reflected in the overall growth and development.

- 3. The course has a bad balance between theory and its application.
- 4. Applicability of the tools/case studies presented in the curriculum is very bad and should be more relevant.
- 5. The courses taught are bad in terms of enhancing entrepreneurship skills
- 6. Curriculum is a bad mix of fundamental topics and latest technology relevant to that topic.
- 7. Curriculum is very bad in terms of facilitating the overall holistic development of the student
- 8. Curriculum is bad in terms of having components to make student employable

- 1. More number of hands-on learning or projects.
- 2. Balance between foundational concepts and the latest technological advancements to be maintained.
- 3. Curriculum should encourage my development of intellectual, emotional, and social skills

- 5. Combination of theoretical knowledge and practical experience to prepare me for the job market.
- 6. I'd like to see more projects or assignments that use current tools and techniques
- 7. If the curriculum stays focused on old topics, it might not prepare me for modern jobs
- 8. Research projects and internships to be more as it will expose me to actual tools and case studies used in the field
- 9. Activities that promote creativity, leadership, and self-awareness. Must be included
- 10. Keeping in mind my holistic development, I want to develop not just academically but also personally, with skills like leadership and emotional intelligence so soft skill based courses.
- 11. A holistic curriculum helps me become more well-rounded and prepared for life
- 12. Training and placement skills to crack interviews to be added in curriculum

Suggested action:

- 1. Taking into account feedback given by students it was understood that many students lack in soft skills required at workplace, to overcome this challenge a provision will be made to include the soft skill and professional skill courses in the new curriculum to be proposed in the BOS of 2023-24 will be signed and several skill enriching certificate courses will be inducted.
- 2. MOOC and Value Added courses as per NEP 2020 to be proposed in the BOS of 2023-24
- 3. Interdisciplinary course as per the guidelines of NEP 2020 to be to be proposed in the BOS of 2023-24
- 4. Major Minor specialization to be removed to give students an in-depth knowledge of the specialization subjects being offered, the change is proposed for the BOS of 2023-24
- 5. Upto date Industry relevant components will be added as part of the curriculum to make student employable and updated with current industry practices.
- 6. To develop independent thinking, teamwork, and management skills, which are crucial for personal and professional growth, departmental Clubs will be established which enhance the social skills and values among the students.
