

- 5. Curriculum is bad in terms of having components to make student employable

Suggestion received from Student Members:

- 1. A holistic curriculum helps me become more well-rounded and prepared for life.
- 2. Training and placement skills to crack interviews to be added in curriculum.
- 3. Course curriculum should help me grow both academically and personally.
- 4. Diversity and real-world application of case studies.
- 5. Provide examples of where technology is integrated into fundamental courses.
- 6. I prefer a variety of ways to be evaluated, not just exams. Quizzes, presentations, and projects help me learn better.
- 7. More internships, hands-on projects, and real-world exposure would help me feel job-ready.
- 8. Practical skills need further focus.
- 9. Innovation and skills for employability to be increased.

Suggested Actions:

- 1. The major minor specialization offered in the program will be discussed in BOS meeting to be scheduled in 2024-25.
- 2. Up to the date industry relevant components will be added as part of curriculum to make student employable.
- 3. More relevant case studies and researches to be discussed in the class.
- 4. MOOC and value added courses as per NEP 2020 will be added to the syllabus.
- 5. Soft skill training will be given to the students along with mock interviews to make them interview ready.
