- Analyze the role of diet and lifestyle modifications in pain management according to Ayurveda.
- Apply Ayurvedic principles to manage pain in various musculoskeletal, neurological, and gastrointestinal conditions.
- Critically evaluate the efficacy and safety of Ayurvedic pain management techniques.
- Integrate Ayurvedic approaches with conventional pain management strategies for a holistic approach.
