



SOP of Program:

Objective:

To assess the prevalence, risk factors, and healthcare needs related to arthritis in Dhanod

Survey questionnaires


70 participants who were quite excited about the session. Among the participants we had all the students of Physiotherapy College and the staff of swarrnim University.
