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




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


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ORIENTATION PROGRAM OF BATCH 2023-24

SOP of Program:





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PHYSIOTHERAPY WEEK (DAY 1) SEMINAR & FOOD STALL

SOP of Seminar:

Set clear objectives: An institute has defined the objectives of the seminar presentation, including the topics to be covered, the target audience, and the expected outcomes. Thus the Acupressure has been selected for BPT students.

Select speakers: an institute Identified speaker who was an expert in their field and can deliver presentations that align with the objectives of the seminar. Dr. Jayesh Thakrar was an ideal candidate for this.

Site Study - Barganza House



House, built in the 17th century and stretching along one whole side of Chandor's village square, is the biggest Portuguese mansion of its kind in Goa and the best example of what Goa's scores of once-grand and glorious mansions have today become. Granted the land by the King of Portugal, the Braganza family built this oversized house, which was later divided into the east and west wings when it was inherited by two sisters from the family.

Both sides are open to the public daily. There are no set tour times, but if you enter either side a family member or representative should give you a guided tour and regale you with a few stories of the lifestyles of the landed gentry during Goa's years of Portuguese rule.

The West Wing belongs to one set of the family's descendants, the Menezes-Braganças. It's well maintained and more like a museum than a home, filled with gorgeous Belgian glass chandeliers, Italian marble floors and antique treasures from Macau, Portugal, China and Europe.

The East Wing is owned by the Pereira-Braganza family, descendants of the other half of the family. It's not as grand and well-maintained as terpart but is beautiful in its own lived-in way and is also with marble from around the world. With the arrival of the Portuguese, the house underwent a gradual change. The façade was made towards the road. With the Portuguese came the influence of the western culture. The ballroom consists of a spacious verandah, long French glass windows, a wooden floor with baroque styled furniture, a large Belgian mirror, crystal chandeliers and crystal lamp holders adorn the wall. Tall solitaire vases, a piano and oil lamps are some of the showpieces in the ballroom

The approach which is practiced at Swarrnim Institute of Design, SSIU was also explained with projects. The need to augment creative design thinking in architecture was given stress, and importance and need of developing framework and approach to design which leads to innovation was discussed.
