#### **Governance and Strategies**

A committee to be formed including members at the level of the senior management/director/deans/equivalent position and representation from the faculty, students, alumni, and regional and local incubators to be ensured. The committee to work in close association with the Swarrnim Incubation Centre on various aspects of formulation and implementation of the Policy.

The committee will guide in the following activities

- To prepare a resource mobilization plan at the university for supporting the pre-incubation, incubation facilities and creation of required infrastructure. The committee will help in preparing a sustainable financial strategy for the above.
- Raising funds from diverse sources DST, DBT, CSIR, BIRAC, MHRD, AICTE, SSIP, Startup India, Gujrat State government and central government, private and corporate sector, sponsorships, donations
- To provide a basic understanding of new business planning, commercial applications for new technical discoveries, general and legal aspects of intellectual property protection, and the management of creativity and innovation in organizational settings.
- To promote and integrate entrepreneurial activities (innovative product/service) across various research projects in each department within the university
- Strategic regional/local/national/ international partnerships by international exchange programs, internships, and engaging the national/international faculty in teaching and research.

#### **Advisory Council**

The committee to be supported and guided by an advisory council composed of experts from Industry (Banking, Human resources, Investment, Life sciences, Engineering, IT, and Legal) with a vested interest in the success of the entrepreneurs. The Advisory team will provide guidance to the top management and Swarrnim Incubation center and IE (Innovation and Entrepreneurship Department) on various aspects from time to time. The advisory council shall ensure that the industry collaborations become an integral part and can help the University by:

Providing resources for faculty/students, programs, and activities

Provide financial support for center operations

Participate in board meetings

- Any novel technological idea that can be upgraded for the commercial proposition, scaling up a laboratory proven concept qualifies for a pre-incubation project. Innovative ideas to go through the pre-incubation step and it is expected that the innovator is interested in commercializing the technology to move to registering the Business within a year of pre-incubation.
- ➤ Selected Ideas to be admitted to "Innovation Space" the pre incubation facility of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University and the university will provide free working space for the nascent entrepreneurs.
- Each student group to be assigned to a senior faculty member for mentorship. Under the mentorship the group/s to prepare a prototype. The student can use the laboratory and other resources of the university for developing the prototype.
- ➤ The prototype developed to be evaluated by a team of experts and based on the market value, a decision to nurture the idea as a startup will be taken
- ➤ The startup to be registered as a student business entity Partnership, LLP, Private Limited Company, One Person Company. Startups to provide a copy of the registration certificate/letter to their academic institution.
- > Swarrnim Incubation center can be utilized by external students who wish to incubate his startup idea. There is an incubation agreement for external students.
- If the student of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University want to quit from his startup, other students who are his team member in the startup can take a lead and run the organization or allow another student to join their startup.

#### **Institutional Infrastructure**

Innovation is linked to enterprises and as part of the lab ecosystem, ventures in this space will have access to programming and other resources:

- ➤ Life science ventures are offered a selection of diverse resources industry-specific programming, wet laboratory, and collaborative co-working space
- > Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will actively foster collaborations with university research centers, IT/ITES, agriculture, food, biotech, and pharmaceutical industry experts, academics, and investors
- Labs to provide fully functional lab space, permits, waste handling in addition to reasonably common lab equipment for research. Access to the conference rooms, event space is also allowed.

#### **Nurturing Innovations and Startups**

Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University 's Innovation and Entrepreneurship Department and Swarrnim Incubation Centre must establish processes for the creation and nurturing of startups/enterprises by students (UG, PG, and Ph.D.), staff (including contractual and project staff), faculty, alumni, and potential startup applicants. The program will ensure to achieve the following:

#### **Pre-Incubation**

The pre-incubation phase prepares the student entrepreneurs for the incubation phase by providing them with prerequisite skills and knowledge to help them validate and assess the ideas and define their business models. The activities to be done in this phase include:

- ❖ Identification of the problems students will visit places like tribal villages, agricultural market yards, hospitals, urban areas to understand and identify the problem areas in various sectors
- ❖ Idea generation Students to develop possible solutions for the problems identified. The idea generated should be novel and submitted for Smart India Hackathon and National Innovation Contest. Shortlisted applicants to be invited to give presentations to the evaluation committee
- ❖ Admission to the Pre incubator This facility to be given to currently enrolled students in any degree program at Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University and includes the following:
  - University shall offer seed loan on generous terms to promote startups in the incubation center
  - Use of laboratory space and equipment
- ❖ Mentoring During the pre-incubation phase selected ideas will go through a series of workshops, webinars, and lecture series to refine the solutions to the problems identified under the able guidance of a mentor. A business plan with market analysis is developed and presented to an expert from industry or academia
- ❖ **Prototype development** Prototype/s of the ideas generated to be developed under the direction of the mentor and tested before applying for incubation
- ❖ The selected students in a pre-incubation can able to apply for sustenance allowance which will be provided by Nodal Institute's recommendation.

#### **Incubation Support:**

Upon completion of the pre-incubation process, successful students to be admitted into the incubation program for converting the novel ideas into successful startups. Startups to be promoted and supported by the university in the following ways:

• The access to pre-incubation and Incubation facility to startups by students, staffs, faculties and if or a mutually acceptable time-frame but should not be more than 30 months)

- The SSIP of Government of Gujarat Rs. 20 lakhs to be earmarked annually in cash and/or kind for Innovation and Entrepreneurial activities (Seed grant for prototype development/ Capability enhancement activities)
- IE Courses at different semester: are the flagship program to be launched as an initiative of the Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University for nascent entrepreneurs (Youth Entrepreneurs/Student Entrepreneurs). The startups shall be administered by an advisory board that includes representatives from the schools of Engineering, Agriculture, Life Sciences, and Management.
- The students of all programs and classifications across Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University can get involved in the entrepreneurial community

#### Provisions to Nurture Innovation and Entrepreneurship for Students and benefits.

- Students are encouraged to develop entrepreneurial mindset through experimental learning by exposing them to training in cognitive skills (e.g., Design thinking, critical thinking etc.) by inviting first generation local entrepreneur or expert to address young mind and through innovative pedagogies. The Swarrnim Startup and Innovation university will routinely organize students events like Idea & innovation competition, hackathons, workshop, boot camps, seminars, conferences, exhibition, mentoring by academic and industry personal throwing real life challenges.
- Students are encouraged to bring some problem statements and motivated to solve the problems with innovation. Best solution provided by students can get award & recognition by Innovation and entrepreneurship department in the form of certification. This will help in creation of idea bank and entrepreneurial mindset among students of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University.
- Student pursuing some entrepreneur venture that are under incubation while studying at Swarrnim startup & innovation university would allow to use address of the university to register their company with due permission from the Swarrnim Startup & Innovation University.
- Interdisciplinary or multidisciplinary. The credits and the grading would be determined by a committee constituted by Swarrnim Startup & Innovation University and concerned department/ institutions. If student startup reaches his startup journey successfully up to prototype will be given credits flexibility according to their course requirement and if student startup reaches his startup journey successfully up to move his startup journey successfully up to move his startup journey successfully up to MVP will be given permission to sit in final examination in respective semester. If student startup reaches his startup journey at scale up stage and breakeven point will allow to give final examination and exemption from regular attendance. This is not applicable to bealth science (BAMS, BHMS, BPT and Nursing).

relaration in the minimum attendance requirements may be given to the students' neurs aviallow them to sit for the examination, with due permission from the university if tentrepreneurial works reach up to prototype.

- A 90% relaxation in the minimum attendance requirements may be given to the students' entrepreneurs to allow them to sit for the examination, with due permission from the university if student entrepreneurial works reach up to MVP.
- Student participating in Entrepreneurial journey can get relaxation from midterm and final University examination. But he must submit assignment (Startup project) for mid semester examination if student has made prototype. If he launches Startup in market and reaches breakeven point and gets traction, he/she will allow giving special final University examination which will be conducted for student entrepreneurs based on request given by student entrepreneurs. Also, faculties of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will give special classes in the form of tutorial or crash course for examination preparation.
- Swarrnim startup & innovation University will permit the student entrepreneurs working on a startup idea right from the first year of their program of the study to convert their startup project as their final year of the project towards degree completion.
- Swarrnim startup & innovation University will explore provision of accommodation to nonresidential students entrepreneurs within its campus for some period during incubation at nominal charges.
- Different clubs formations will be done by Innovation & Entrepreneurship Department for creating awareness about entrepreneurial world like E-cell, corporate entrepreneurship club and finance club.
- A student can opt to work on his/her venture alternatively in place of their major/minor Project, or summer internship.
- Student participating in Entrepreneurial journey may avail the benefits of the Deferred Placement Policy in order to work on their startups and seek deferred placements as per the terms and provisions the policy
- Students to take a semester/year break to work on their startups and student entrepreneurs may earn academic credits for their efforts while creating an enterprise. University to set up a committee constituted by Deans of the school for the review of the startup by students and based on the progress made, it may consider giving appropriate credits or relaxation in giving chance to appear in the exams.
- Student entrepreneurs who are participating in entrepreneurial journey and created prototype will be promoted in different social media and print media free of cost and his entrepreneurial biography and photo will be put on Entrance wall of the University and Incubation center and chances to become brand ambassador of the University.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University shall Start a special annual award i.e., Innovation and Entrepreneurship Award to recognize outstanding ideas, successful enterprise lunch and contributors for promoting innovation and entrepreneurial ecosystem within the Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University offers full-time different programs and Innovation and Innovation startup and Innovation university offers full-time different programs and Innovation and Innovation startup and Innovation university offers full-time different programs and Innovation university of the program of the pr

- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will create Swarrnim Innovation and new venture Development Fund which will work as a soft loan to student with zero interest or equity sharing basis subject to approval of Competent authorities of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University. Student entrepreneurs will return the loan amount after 6 months or more than 6 months as approved by higher authorities of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University after some alternative arrangement like getting seed fund from SSIP or other government funds. In worst case, if student entrepreneur is not getting funds from any govt. Schemes, he must return the loan amount to Swarrnim Innovation and new venture Development Fund in six months
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will give flexibility in course fees for student entrepreneurs who are getting incubation facility in Swarrnim Incubation Centre. Also, all semester fees for student entrepreneurs who have successfully reached their startup journey at Scale up stage and about to become Unicorn or valuation of 100 cr. of the company will be waived off as a financial reward. This will give inspiration to others to participate in entrepreneurial journey.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University to link the startups to other seed-fund providers/angel funds/venture funds or may have seed fund once the incubation activities mature
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will give reimbursement of participation fees and travelling expenses to Student Entrepreneurs who have done show case their product in different Startup fests and competitions subject to prior approval of competent authorities of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will assist Student Entrepreneurs in development of state of art product or service (User Experience) by connecting them to different technological labs and eminent experts in India and foreign countries.
- The Swarrnim Incubation Centre of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University must conduct different seminar and workshop on Intellectual property rights where experts from IPR will give practical insights on every aspect of IPR (Intellectual Property Rights).

#### **IPR** Evaluation

All IPR related issues to be addressed keeping in view the policy of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University. The IPR policy and the procedures for filing and evaluation of IPR, ownership, royalty sharing as applicable to all the full and part-time employees and the students. The IPR policy to include the following:

✓ Evaluation of IP – All IP evaluations to be done by the IP facilitation Cell of the University. The IP facilitation cell will assist all schools of the university in all matters relating to intellectual property. Other responsibilities of the IP cell include – protection of the intellectual property where appropriate and will review infringements, maintain central databases with patent applications, issued patents, trademarks, and copyrights, licenses, and agreements, coordinate with various departments in the stating and preparing license and other agreements, review and approve all agreements relating

- o Determine the contribution made and the ownership of the IP developed
- O Determine whether an IP is novel and qualifies the eligibility so given under respective statute in India or foreign countries
- o Determine whether the IP has a reasonable chance for commercialization
- ✓ **Product Ownership Rights** –Ownership of the rights to follow the norms given below:
  - When university's facilities/funds are used substantially used or when IPR is developed as a
    part of the curriculum/academic activity, IPR to be jointly owned by the inventor/s and the
    university
  - o If IPR is developed by innovators not using the university's facilities and if done outside of office hours (by staff and faculty) or not as a part of the curriculum by the student, then IPR will be entirely owned by inventors in proportion to the contributions made by them. Inventors can decide to license the technology to third parties or use the technology the way they deem fit
  - O Any dispute in ownership will be adjudicated by a five-member committee appointed by the top management, Swarrnim Startup, and Innovation University. The committee will consist of two faculty members, two of the university's alumni/industry experts, and one legal advisor. The committee will examine the issue after meeting the inventors and help them settle the issues.
  - O University's incubation center shall be only a coordinator and facilitator for providing services to faculty, staff, and the students. They do not have any say on how the innovation has been carried out, how it is patented, or how it is to be licensed. A committee consisting of the faculty with experience in technology translation can examine the worthiness of filing the patent/s by the university
  - University's technical body related to incubation/IPR/technology-licensing will consist of faculty and experts who have excelled in technology translation
  - Interdisciplinary research and publication on startup and entrepreneurship to be promoted by the university

# Organizational Capacity, Human Resources, and Incentives

- ❖ Faculty and staff to be encouraged to take courses in innovation, entrepreneurship, and venture development. University would develop academic and non-academic incentives and reward mechanisms for all the stakeholders that actively contribute and support entrepreneurship agenda and activities
  - Faculty appreciation in the form of incentives/certificate (such as Innovator of the year, best innovation of the year etc.)/commendation/ notification on the website.
  - Performance criteria to be developed and used for evaluation of annual performance Stakeholders to be allowed to use office and lab space, facilities, and services

#### **Creating Innovation Pipeline and Pathways for Entrepreneurs**

Mechanisms to encourage students to the innovation and incubation activities will be promoted and include the following:

- > Spreading awareness among the students, faculty, and staff about the value of entrepreneurship and its role in carer development or employability
- > Students would be encouraged to develop the entrepreneurial mindset through experiential learning by exposing them to training in cognitive skills (design and critical thinking), by inviting the local entrepreneurs or experts to address budding entrepreneurs. Initiatives like idea and innovation competitions, hackathons, workshops, boot camps, seminars, conferences, exhibitions, mentoring by the academic and industry personnel with real-life challenges, awards, and recognition to be periodically organized
- ➤ Prepare the students for creating startup through education, and by the integration of education with enterprise-related activities
- ➤ The University will follow the guidelines of the Institution's Innovation Council (IICs) as and allocate budget for its activities
- ➤ IICs to guide the university in conducting activities related to innovation, startup and entrepreneurship development
- ➤ University to connect the startups and companies with the wider entrepreneurial ecosystem by providing support to the students in the pre-startup phase. Networking events to be organized to create a platform for collaboration with investors and to pitch in the ideas
- ➤ University to provide business incubation facilities: leasing of the premises at low cost, laboratory space, research facilities, IT services, training and mentoring, and hosting the details of the innovation and entrepreneurship strategies on the host website
- A culture to be promoted to understand that money is risk capital and the entrepreneur must utilize these funds and return

#### Provisions to Nurture Innovation and Entrepreneurship for faculty Startup and benefits

Only those technologies should be taken up for faculty startups that originate from within the same university. Provisions include:

Faculties are expected to identify some problems in their teaching domain or inter-disciplinary domains and find out tentative feasible solutions in every quatre. These things must bring in notice to Swarrnim Incubation center and the incubation manager must maintain MIS of above activities. This will help in understanding the mindset of faculties towards entrepreneurship and help in annual appraisal of faculties. Those faculties who are not participating in above mentioned activities will be answerable and accountable to competent authorities of the Swarrnim Startup and Innovation Largeristy if they ask.

- Faculty startup may consist of faculty members alone, non-teaching Staffs, or with faculty of other Institutes or with alumni or with other entrepreneurs.
- Faculty to separate the on-going research at the institute from the work done at the startup
- Faculty who has successfully created MVP will get flexible timing for working in Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University and his daily work will be assigned accordingly on condition that it will not hamper progress of the university.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will create Swarrnim Innovation and new venture Development Fund which will work as a soft loan to faculty with zero interest or equity sharing basis subject to approval of Competent authorities of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University. Faculty startup founders will return the loan amount after 6 months or more than 6 months as approved by higher authorities of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University after some alternative arrangement like getting seed fund from SSIP or other government funds or angel investors.
  - In worst case, if faculty startup founder unable to get funds from govt schemes and other funding avenues, he must return the loan amount to Swarrnim Innovation and new venture Development Fund within six months.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will give reimbursement of participation fees and travelling expenses to faculty startup founders who have done show case their product in different Startup fests and competitions subject to prior approval of competent authorities of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will assist faculty startup founders in development of state of art product or service (User Experience) by connecting them to different technological labs and eminent experts in India and foreign countries.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will provide extra 60 days paid leave for faculty who is participating in entrepreneurial journey who is getting incubation support from Swarrnim Incubation Centre subject to requirement of work and approval from higher authorities of the university.
- The role of the faculty may vary from being the founder/ cofounder/ owner of the startup
- Faculty/staff holding the executive or managerial position for more than three months in a startup are required to go on sabbatical leave without pay/utilize existing leave
- Faculty cannot accept gifts from the startups
- A faculty who has reached his startup journey successfully up to creation of MVP can avail the leave for a maximum period of one semester/year or even more (pre-approval taken from top management of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University) if the startup gets selected by an outside national or international accelerator.
- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University will reduce the teaching load if faculty who is participating in entrepreneurial journey and if his/ her startup has successfully made MVP will get 50% reduction in workload and will get full salary despite of reduction in teaching load.
  - Swarpin Startup and Innovation University will reduce the teaching load if faculty who is the startup has successfully reached Scale up Stage 190 % reduction in workload and will get full salary despite of reduction in teaching load.

- In case, the faculty/staff holds an executive or managerial position for more than three months in a startup, then they would go on sabbatical/leave without pay/earned leave.
- Participation in entrepreneurial related activities must be considered as a required activity of the faculty in addition to teaching, R&D projects, industrial consultancy, and academic and administrative duties and must be considered while evaluating the annual performance of the faculty. Every faculty may be encouraged to mentor at least one startup and if his mentor startup has successfully reached up to minimum viable product will get financial reward and appreciation from top management.

- Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University shall Start a special annual award i.e., Innovation and Entrepreneurship Award to recognize outstanding ideas, successful enterprise lunch and contributors for promoting innovation and enterprise ecosystem within the Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University.
- Faculty Startup founders who are quitting teaching job at Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University for any reason can also avail or continue the incubation facility. It will not affect the support systems to faculty startup founders.
- For faculty startup founders assuming board position in Startup, their director identification number (DIN) is required to be submitted to HR office for record keeping.
