


Pre Admission Process (9 Steps)

RESERVATION OF SEATS

- SSIU acts on the reservation policy as decided by the UGC and State Government from Time to time.
- A student seeking admission on reserved seat is required to produce a Certificate of Caste from the competent authority.
- No caste certificate shall be valid unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the competent authority.
- If a candidate fails to submit the necessary caste certificate as required within the stipulated time, his/her candidature shall be considered for admission under unreserved category as per merit.
- Reserved seats remaining vacant in any category shall be converted to open category seats.

For the purpose of admission, the seats shall be reserved for the candidate who are of Gujarat origin and falling under the following categories and in following proportion, Namely,

- a. schedule caste 07%
- b. schedule tribes 15%
- c. socially and educationally backward classes, including widows and orphans of any caste -27%
- d. Economically weaker sections 10%

SCHOLARSHIPS

MIGRATION POLICY

- Students from other Universities can seek migration to Swarrnim University, subject to following conditions:
 - Migration will be allowed only in 2nd year-3rd semester/ 5 semester if the course duration is of 4 yrs.
 - Students must have successfully completed 1st year/ 1st and 2nd semesters as per the passing criteria laid down by the parent University. Student should not have any backlog.
 - Students must be pursuing a regular programme in the parent University.
 - 1. Having the same entry eligibility condition as the programme in which he/she is seeking migration.
 - 2. Students, if he had continued in his/her parent University would have been awarded the same degree in which he/she is seeking migration.
 - Students seeking migration should be having the syllabi in the 1st year/ 1st and 2nd semester at least 50% identical to that of Swarrnim University. In case of deficiencies, candidates shall have to complete the bridge/additional course(s) as may be prescribed by the Equivalence Committee for which a fee may be charged.
 - Student has to confirm the bridge/additional courses, from the head of the concerned department or admission department.
 - The score obtained by the candidates in the Course of Study for the entry level qualifications as recommended by the Equivalence Committee for credit transfer shall be carried over for calculating the CG PA for successful completion of the Programme.
 - Improvement in score of a Course Unit qualified prior to admission to Swarrnim University shall not be permitted.
 - Candidates migrating from other universities shall submit the following documents at the time of their admission:
 - i. No objection Certificate (NOC) or Migration certificate from his/her parent University.
 - ii. Authentic copy of the detailed syllabus, scheme of teaching and evaluation of the course of study pursued by him at his/her parent University.
 - iii. Attested copy of statement of Marks/Grade Card of the courses completed.



- iv. Attested copies of testimonials relating to basic qualifications and experience etc., .which were pre-requisite for admission in his parent University.
- The procedure for selection of candidates shall be as laid down by the admission Committee with the consent of the concerned department' Heads.
- Reservation of the seats under this category shall be as per the provisions of Act, Statutes and Ordinances.

Subject: Fee Refund Policy 2023-24

Respected Madam/Sir,

The University Grants Commission receives many representations/complaints from the students/parents on the non-refund of fees by the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) on cancellation/withdrawal of admissions.

Students should be allowed a full refund of fees within a specified period to opt for a course they choose.

The Commission has considered the matter in its 570th meeting held on 27 June 2023, and after considering the relevant factors decided, the following fee refund policy for the academic session 2023-24:

- Notwithstanding anything contained in any guidelines/ prospectus/ notification/ schedule, a full refund of fees shall be made by the HEIs on account of all cancellations of admission/migrations of students up to 30 September 2023 and with a deduction of not more than Rs. 1,000, as a processing fee, up to 31 October 2023.
- For any admission schedule extending/commencing beyond/after 31 October 2023, the provisions contained in the UGC Notification issued in October 2018 on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates shall apply (reproduced below for ready reference):

Category	Percentage of Refund of fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after formally notified last date of admission
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission

It may also be noted that the UGC has notified the Redressal of Grievances of Students Regulations, 2023 wherein "delay in, or denial of, the refund of fees due to a student who withdraws admission within the time mentioned in the prospectus, subject to guidelines, if any, issued by the Commission, from time to time" has been defined as one of the grievances.

The Higher Education Institutions are requested to ensure compliance with the fee refund policy for the academic session 2023-24 and redress any grievance by the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023.

Any HEI violating the provisions of UGC Fee Refund Policy 2023-24 shall be liable for punitive action as notified in Clause 5 of the UGC Notification on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates issued in October 2018.
