Fewer applications from them will deprive the deserving students of your state from benefits of this Scheme.

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## PRADHAN MANTRI UCHCHATAR SHIKSHA PROTSAHAN (PM-USP) YOJANA

## GUIDELINES FOR THE COMPONENT SCHEME – CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (PM-USP CSSS)

(Applicable for academic year 2022-23 onwards)

## 1. Objective

To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from poor families to meet a part of their day-to-day expenses while pursuing higher studies.

## 2. Scope

The scholarships are awarded by Ministry of Education, Government of India on the basis of results of Higher Secondary / Class XII Board Examination. A maximum of 82,000 fresh scholarships per annum are provided for pursuing graduate / postgraduate degree in colleges and universities and for professional courses, such as Medical, Engineering etc.

## 3. Allocation of Scholarship

The total number of scholarships are divided amongst the State Education Boards based on the State's population in the age group of 18-25 years, after segregating share of CBSE and ICSE on the basis of number of students passing out from various Boards in the country. 50% of the scholarships are earmarked for girls. Out of the total scholarship slots earmarked for UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, 3% slots shall be earmarked for the students from the UT of Ladakh. The number of scholarships allotted to a State Education Board is distributed amongst pass outs of the Humanities, Science and Commerce streams in the ratio of 3:3:1. In case of shortfall in the number of applications, the scholarship slots shall be interoperable among categories (Gen, OBC, SC & ST), gender (Female, Male) and State Quota to maximize use of slots for fresh scholarships with effect from academic year 2022-23, subject to the condition that guidelines of Ministry of Finance and NITI Aayog regarding SC/ST fund allocation of the schemes are adhered to.

#### 4. Eligibility for Scholarship

Students who are above 80<sup>th</sup> percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent;

- Pursuing regular degree courses and not correspondence or distance mode or pursuing Diploma courses;
- Pursuing courses at colleges/institutions recognized by All India Council for Technical Education and respective Regulatory Bodies concerned;
- Not availing benefit of any other scholarship schemes including State run scholarship schemes/ fee waiver & reimbursement scheme;
- v. Students with gross parental/family income upto Rs. 4.5 lakh per annum are eligible for scholarship under the scheme. Income certificate will be required only for the fresh applicants;
- vi. Student changing his/ her college/institute of study will be allowed to continue/renew the scholarship provided the course of study and the institution is having valid AISHE Code; The AISHE code can be checked in the portal <a href="https://aishe.gov.in/aishe/aisheCode">https://aishe.gov.in/aishe/aisheCode</a>
- vii. Students who missed to apply for renewal of application online on NSP will be allowed to apply for renewal of scholarship for subsequent year on NSP, if he/she fulfils eligibility condition for renewal;
- viii. For renewal of scholarship in each year of study, besides getting at least 50% marks in the Annual Examination, maintenance of adequate attendance of at least 75%, will also be the criteria. Complaints against the student regarding any in disciplined or criminal behaviour including any complaints of having indulged in ragging, will lead to forfeiture of scholarship;
- ix. Beneficiaries/ Applicants under the scheme must apply online in the National Scholarships Portal (www.scholarships.gov.in) for the fresh/renewal scholarships. Fresh/Renewal applications sent directly to the Ministry of Education shall not be accepted.


#### 5. Reservation

Students belonging to reserved categories/weaker sections /minorities etc. are eligible to get benefit of reservation on the basis of merit, subject to Central Reservation Policy [i.e. 15% seats are earmarked for SCs, 7.5% for STs and 27 % for OBCs and 5% horizontal reservation for students with Benchmark Disabilities (Disability of 40% or more) in all the categories]. The Central Reservation Policy will be applicable in filling the slots against each year's target. If slots under a specific group is not filled after considering all the States/UTs, the vacant slots will be allocated to other categories so that maximum number of eligible students can get the benefit, subject to overall ceiling of slots.



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# 6. Procedure for Application

- The applications are received online only. Verification of credentials of the students like caste, educational qualifications etc. are done through DIGILOCKER facility of the MeITY, Govt. of India.
- National Scholarships Portal (NSP) (www.scholarships.gov.in) will provide the timelines for opening & closing of the portal.
- The Guidelines for application, verification, selection and disbursement of scholarship will be as per the NSP.
- Selection list would be generated/displayed on NSP.
- v. Online applications will be verified at two levels i.e by the Institute, where the student is studying and thereafter by the concerned State Higher Education Department or any other Agency/ Official nominated by the State as State Nodal Agency (both for fresh and renewal applicants).
- vi. Latest guideline on Timelines will be made available on NSP.
- vii. Students will not be permanently debarred for scholarships due to delay to renew or verification. However, students will have to submit renewal applications within a cut-off date. Renewal for that year will not be allowed if an applicant misses this deadline.

# 7. Rate and Duration of Scholarship (from financial year 2022-23)

The rate of scholarship is Rs.12,000/-per annum at Graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20,000/-per annum at Post-Graduation level. Students pursuing professional courses, in case, where the duration of course is five (5) years/Integrated course will get Rs. 20,000/-per annum in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year. However, students pursuing technical courses such as B.Tech, B.Engg. will get scholarship up to graduation level only i.e. Rs. 12,000 p.a. for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year and Rs. 20,000 in the 4<sup>th</sup> year.


**Note:** The rate of scholarship is Rs.10,000/-per annum for first three years of fresh/renewal scholarships with respect to academic year 2021-22, even if the actual release happens in FY 2022-23.

# 8. Payment of Scholarship

Students are required to have the bank accounts opened, especially, in their name for availing the benefits under the scheme. The scholarship will be disbursed directly into the savings bank accounts of the beneficiaries through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)



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mode. The student can track their payment status from the template "Know Your Payment" in the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) portal [ https://pfms.nic.in/Users/LoginDetails/Login.aspx] either by indicating Aadhaar number or bank account number or NSP Application ID.

# 9. For Colleges/Universities

College and Universities will apprise the students about the "PM-USP CSSS" during admission. Aadhaar based authentication of Institute Nodal Officer (INO)/ State Nodal Officer (SNO) is mandatory for every Institution/State before verification of the applications. INO/SNO should be a regular employee.

## 10. For State Government/State Boards

Adequate publicity of the scheme may be initiated through the Schools/ Colleges/ Institutions to create awareness and to facilitate/ assist the applicants in rural area to apply for scholarship online on NSP.

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# Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University Scholarship and Financial Assistance Policy

1. Purpose the Scholarship Policy defines the eligibility requirements, application procedure, and terms of scholarship awards at Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University. The policy is designed to support and encourage students who exhibit academic distinction, financial necessity, leadership potential, and a dedication to enriching the university community.

Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University, Gandhinagar with its student-centric approach has established a clear policy outlining rules and standard administrative procedures for granting scholarships to deserving students from all backgrounds this facility aims to support families by providing financial assistance to continue their studies.

2. Scope This policy applies to all current and prospective students of Swarrnim Startup and Innovation University encompassing undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programs. This scholarship policy defines the rules and regulations along with the procedure to be followed by the University with the details of various existing scholarship schemes, its eligibility criteria, scholarship benefits, and application process.

The scholarship scheme was discussed and deliberated in the BOM and Finance Committee meeting which comprise the President, Provost, and all other members. The Scholarship scheme with the recommendations of the University's BOM and Finance Committee will be placed before the University's Governing Body for concurrence.

Upon concurred the Registrar issues the Notification of Scholarship scheme which will be disseminated to all the Deans/Principals of all the Schools, staff and students and will also be made available on the University's website.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA


The eligibility for scholarships varies based on the type of scholarship such as merit, merit cum means, reservation, government eligibility criteria, and more.

The specific guidelines for eligibility determined and approved by the Board of Governors will be communicated through notification by the University each academic year.

When awarding the scholarship, other factors considered include previous academic performance, academic excellence, achievements in any sports, and financial hardship of deserving candidates.

All eligible students must follow and complete the process defined by the University well within the specified time to be considered for scholarships. In some cases, recommendations from competent authorities will be taken into account for financially disadvantaged students. Students seeking financial assistance must apply along with the required information and documents to assess the student's financial situation. The University student's case and may request additional information and documents. Student's responsibility to ensure all documents are submitted an Incomplete or inadequate information will result in the application.

4. Types of Scholarships: The University offers a variety of scholarships to students in each discipline every academic year based on their previous academic performance, financial conditions, and recognized academic or sporting achievements. The University follows a specific procedure to offer various scholarship schemes to students who enrol in any programs of the University. This assistance may continue for academic years provided that students maintain good performance in their studies and sports, and attend classes regularly do not involved in indiscipline activities.

# 4.1 Early Bird Scholarship

The Early Bird Scholarship is a financial assistance program for prospective students who demonstrate academic excellence and submit their admission request with fee payment well before the defined dates of admission. The scholarship encourages timely application submissions and is granted on a first come first serve basis. It applies to all the programs offered by the University.

The Scholarship may range from 5% to 100% on the tuition fee, depending on the candidate's Previous academic records.

**4.2. Merit-Based Scholarships:** This scholarship is awarded based on academic achievement and ranges from 5% to 100% of the tuition fees. It is granted to students based on exceptional achievements, not financial need and is designed to recognize excellence in academics, sports, the arts, leadership, and other areas.

The scholarship is awarded based on previous academic marks with a minimum requirement of 75% in the last examination.

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**4.3.** Need-Based Scholarships: Need-based scholarships are awarded to students based on financial need aiming to help those from low- and middle-income households to afford higher education. The scholarship amount is determined by students' household income and prior exam scores.

The annual income of the family should not exceed Rs. 5 lacs, and the student's prior exam sc ore should have been at least 60%. The scholarship can cover 5% to 100% of the tuition fee and applies to tuition fees only.

**4.4 Employee Benefit Scholarship:** the University has introduced the Scholarship for Employee Wards aims to support employees' children by providing financial support. The program aims to lower education costs for the families of employees and recognize the contributions to the university.

The Scholarship will cover up to 50% of the tuition fee based on the academic performance.

The scholarship will be on Tuition Fee only

- 4.5. Special Category Scholarships
- <u>i. Gender-Based Scholarships</u>: This scholarship aims to incourage female students in underrepresented programs.
- ii. <u>Cultural and Artistic Scholarships</u>: This scholarship aims for students excelling in cultural or artistic activities.
- iii. <u>Leadership Scholarships:</u> This scholarship aims for students demonstrating strong leadership skills in student governance, clubs, or community service.

The Scholarship will cover up to 50% of the tuition fee coverage based on academic records. Applied to Tuition Fee only.

**4.6. Alumni Scholarship** Alumni Scholarships are available to students who have completed their degree program and wish to pursue another education at the university. For example, a student who has finished the BBA Program at Rai University and wants to pursue the MBA program again is eligible for an Alumni Scholarship.

The scholarship covers 25% of the 1st Year tuition fee and is applicable for the 1st year fee only.

**4.7 Other Government Scholarship** In addition to its own scholarship programs, Rai University regularly provides academic guidance to its students regarding qualifications, application processes, and benefits of numerous government scholarships. The university supports eligible

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students in securing state and **federal scholarship** benefits by urging them to apply for pertinent scholarships. Below are some of the details of several government scholarships:

## A. Scholarships for Freeship Cards

The government offers full tuition and other fees as a scholarship to SC or ST students accepted into a program under the State quota or University quota through the government's admission committee (ACPC) and who present the original free ship card issued by the state government. Students must apply through government portals.

B. The Gujarat Government's Digital Scholarships for Students Who Are OBC, SC, or ST The Gujarati government has established the Digital Gujarat Scholarship program to offer financial aid to SC, ST, or OBC students. The detailed guidelines for various digital Gujarat scholarship schemes, including the online application process, eligibility requirements, and a list of required documents are updated on a yearly basis and can be accessed at the following link:

# C. Scholarship under the Mukhyamantri Yuva Swavalamban Yojana (MYSY)

The Gujarati government in India offers scholarships to students from underprivileged social and economic backgrounds seeking higher education under the मख्यमत्री यवा स्वावलवन योजना [Mukhya Mantri Yuva Swavalamban Yojana (MYSY) program]. Eligible students enrolled in undergraduate and graduate programs at accredited colleges and universities in Gujarat can apply for the grant. # D. Scholarship under the Chief Minister Scholarship Scheme (CMSS)

The Gujarati government has introduced the CMSS Scholarship program to provide financial aid to eligible students Detailed information including requirements and eligibility criteria can be found on the MYSY scholarship portal <a href="https://scholarships.gujarat.gov.in/">https://scholarships.gujarat.gov.in/</a>. This happens annually.

E. National Minority Scholarship Program The scheme aims to provide scholarships to economically disadvantaged minority students to enhance their employability and increase their access to higher education. The scholarship can be used at an Indian higher secondary school, college, or university, whether they are government, or private institutions. Detailed instructions for the CMSS Scholarship program are periodically on the National Scholarship

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4.8 Scholarships for Entrepreneurs and Innovators:

- For students with exceptional entrepreneurial projects or innovations.
- Criteria:
  - Submission of a detailed proposal reviewed by the Swarrnim Entrepreneurship and Innovation Council (SEIC).
  - Selection based on originality, feasibility, and potential societal or economic impact.

## 4.9 Alumni Scholarships:

- Exclusive to children or relatives of SSIU alumni.
- Criteria:
  - o A flat 20% tuition fee waiver.

## 5. Application Process

## 5.1. Application Submission


Students interested in the scholarship complete the following steps

- a) Fill out the scholarship application form available on the university website.
- b) Attach required documents including academic transcripts, financial records, and certificates of achievement.
- c) Submit the completed application to the Scholarship Committee by the designated deadline.

#### 5.2. Review and Selection

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- i. The Scholarship Committee evaluates all applications.
- ii. Evaluation is based on the eligibility criteria, the quality of the application, and the fund availability.
- iii. Final decisions of Scholarship Committee are communicated to the applicants.



## 6. Scholarship Terms and Conditions

#### 6.1. Award Disbursement

- > Scholarships are typically applied directly to tuition fees or given as a stipend.
- > The specific amount and duration of the scholarship are detailed in the award letter.

## 6.2. Renewal of Scholarships

Most scholarships are renewable annually, subject to the recipient maintaining the required performance standards (academic, sports, attendance and discipline etc.)

> Students must reapply or confirm continued eligibility for renewal.

## 6.3. Withdrawal or Termination

- > The university has the authority to revoke or terminate a scholarship if the recipient doesn't meet the specified conditions or is found guilty of misconduct.
- > If a student leaves a program without completing it, they will be required to repay the awarded scholarship amount that was awarded to them.

## 6.4. Scholarship Suspension

> Scholarships can be put on hold if the student is on academic probation or if the student takes a leave of absence.

## 6.5. Reconsideration and Appeals

i. Students who do not receive a scholarship or whose scholarship is revoked may request reconsideration or appeal the decision by submitting a written petition to the Scholarship Committee. The university's final decision will be binding on the student and other stakeholders.

#### 7. Responsibilities

## 7.1. Scholarship Committee

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i. The role involves implementing, administering, and monitoring the Scholarship



Policy.

ii. It includes reviewing applications, selecting recipients, and ensuring adherence to policy provisions.

# 7.2. Onus to deposit government/ other scholarship

i. The student and parent have the sole responsibility to promptly submit the government-awarded scholarship to the university as fees.

## 8. Communication

Information regarding scholarship opportunities, deadlines, and application processes will be communicated to students through the university's official channels, including the website, Emails and Notice board.

## 9. Terms and Conditions:

- Scholarships are applicable only to tuition fees unless explicitly mentioned.
- Continuation of scholarships in subsequent semesters requires maintaining a minimum academic performance of 8.0 CGPA (or equivalent) and adherence to university policies.
- Misrepresentation of information or misuse of scholarships will lead to immediate cancellation and recovery of the awarded amount.

## 7. Monitoring and Review:

- The Scholarship Committee will review the policy periodically to ensure it remains effective and aligned with the university's goals.
- Feedback from students and stakeholders will be incorporated to improve the policy.

# Mukhyamantri Yuva Swavalamban Yojana

#### Details

Mukhymantri Yuva Swavalamban Yojana or MYSY Scholarship is a scholarship scheme that is offered to the economically weaker section students of Gujarat. All those students who wish to pursue higher education like diploma courses, engineering, pharmacy course, medical course, etc apply for MYSY scholarship every year

#### Objective

The main objective of the MYSY Scholarship Scheme is to help those students financially who are not being able to finance their education due to low family income. Through this scholarship scheme, financial assistance will be provided to those students so that they can continue their education without any problem.

#### Types of Scholarship Under MYSY Scholarship

There are three types of scholarships that are offered under the MYSY Scholarship which are as follows:-

- 1. Tuition fee grant
- 2. Hostel grant
- **3.** Book/instruments grant

#### Features and Benefits of the MYSY Scholarship

- 1. Under the MYSY scholarship scheme, non-reserve students will also get financial help for buying books and equipment.
- 2. Those students who are in Gujarat medical education research society and dental courses will get financial assistance of Rs 10 lakh over 5 years
- 3. For government jobs, there is an age relaxation given to all category students. This age relaxation is of 5 years
- 4. All those students who wish to appear in the competitive exam will be provided training under training centers.
- 5. The government will also provide assistance of Rs 1200 per month for 10 months if in that region there is no higher education facility or government hostel.
- 6. All the students who have passed class 10th and 12th with 80% and have opted for diploma courses will get Rs 25000 per year or 50% fees whichever is less.
- 7. Under the MYSY scholarship scheme free of cost outfits, reading material etc will be provided by the government

#### **Eligibility**

- For scholarship in Diploma admissions, the candidate should have passed the Std X from a recognized board from the state of Gujarat with a minimum 80 percentile in the board examination
- 2. For scholarship in Bachelor's degree programs, the candidates should have passed Std XII Science/ General stream from a recognized board from the state of Gujarat with a minimum 80 percentile in the board examination.
- 3. For Diploma to Degree students, the minimum eligibility criteria for availing the benefits of the scheme is a 65% mark at the Diploma level examination from a recognized university situated in the state of Gujarat.
- 4. The candidates whose parents annual income is not more than Rs. 6,00,000/- per annum shall only be considered eligible for the said scheme.

5. The State Government has approved the validity of the income certificate for three financial years from the date of issue. Accordingly, a candidate who has a valid income certificate need not have to issue it again for the next three years financial years.

#### **Application Process**

- 1. Applicants need to visit the official website of MYSY scholarship.
- 2. On the homepage, click on login/register for 2023.
- 3. Now applicants have to click on a Fresh Application.
- 4. If applicants are already registered on the portal then they have to log in with their credentials and if applicants are not registered on the portal then they have to register first.
- 5. On the next page, where applicants have to enter all the required details that is board, University, stream, passing year, admission year, enrollment number, mobile number etc.
- 6. Now click on get password
- 7. After that registration, form will open.
- 8. Now applicants have to enter all the required details in this registration form.
- 9. Attach all the important documents.
- 10. Click on submit
