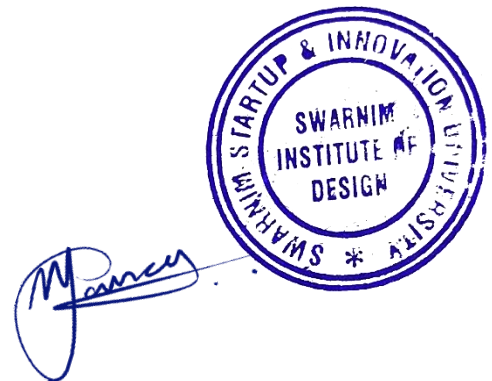

### Introduction about the activity:

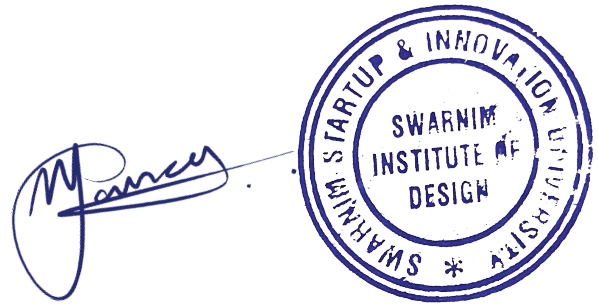


### Details about the activity:

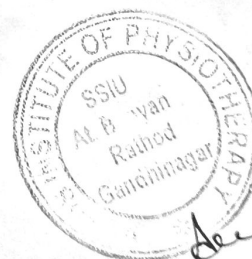
#### ❖ Brief outline addressed in the event :

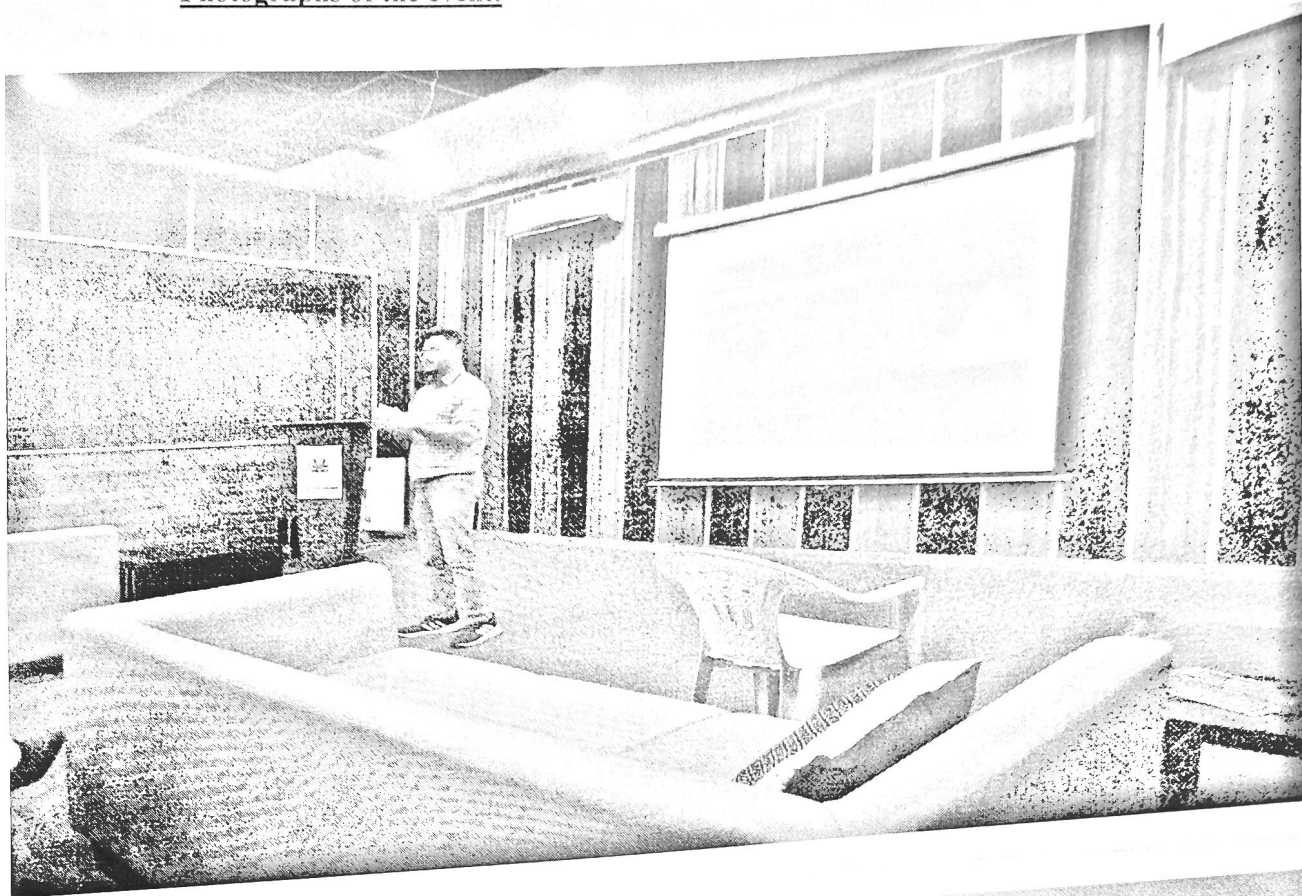

### ❖ Significance/ Outcome

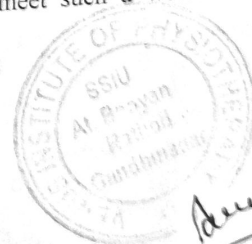
Student took active part in the activity, they were quite happy and few also planned and thinking about such type of start-ups.
