Introduction about the activity:

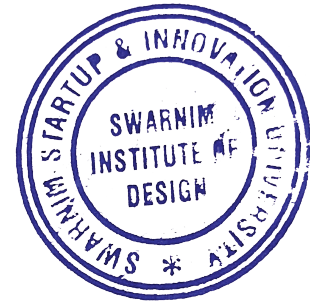

Details about the activity:

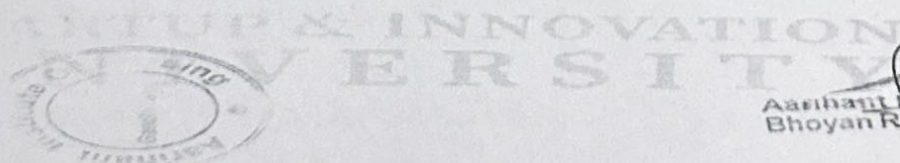

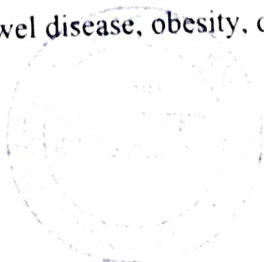
B. Food Safety
